

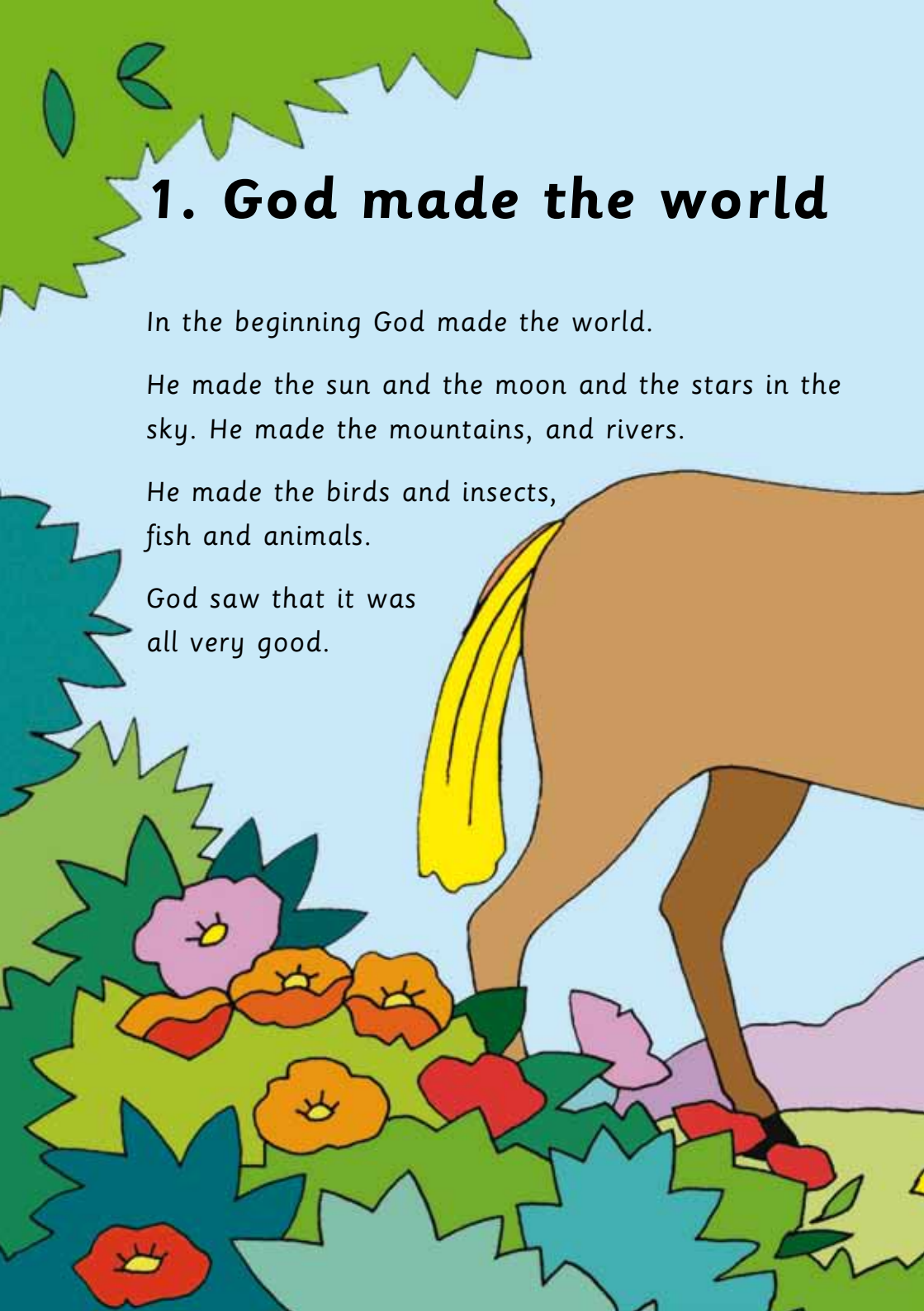
# 1. God made the world

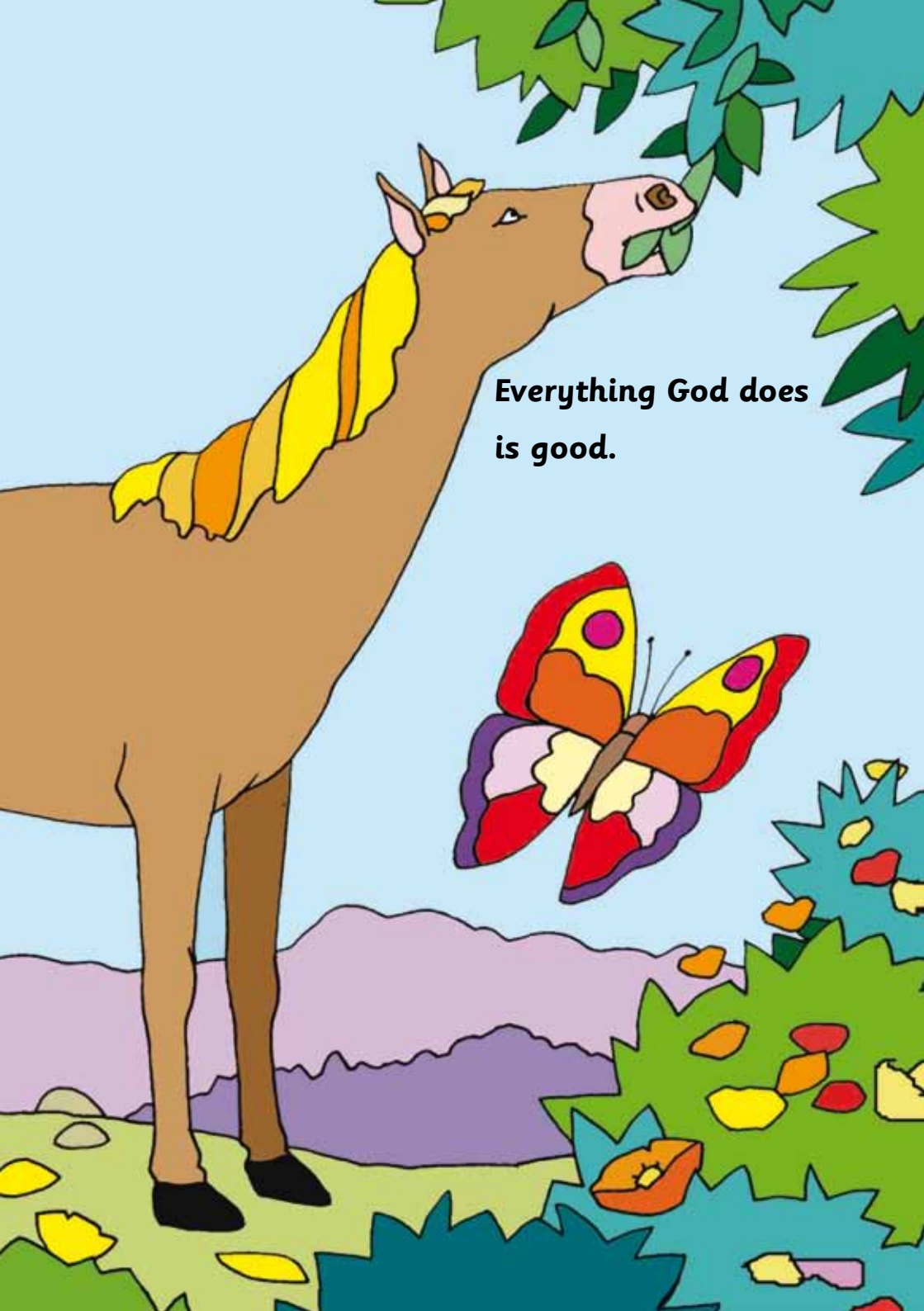
In the beginning God made the world.

One day Adam and Eve disobeyed God.


God had told them not to eat the fruit from one tree in the middle of the garden.
